Bible Class 2017

How well do you know your Bible? Would you like to know more? During 2017 Simon Helme will offer a number of one off evening meetings looking at various books and topics from the Bible linked in to the IBRA Bible Notes that many in the church use.

The evenings will offer an overview of the book or topic, drawing out main themes and issues of interpretation and application for Christian discipleship.

January 26th will look at the Book of Leviticus, much quoted but hardly ever read. In future months we will look at 1&2 Timothy, Atonement, Exodus, Isaiah 1-39, Acts 13-28, Judges, Grace.

(open to women too!) Thursday 19th January 7.45pm 'Making Sense of God'

Simon Helme will give a talk in the Vibe summarising Tim Keller's book 'Making Sense of God' and drawing out the main arguments. The book looks at sceptical objections to faith and enquires about what role can faith and religion play in modern life and can anyone believe in Christianity? Topics to be covered include: Why does anyone need religion? Isn't religion based on faith and secularism on evidence? Religion is more than you think it is: A meaning that suffering can't take away from you; Why can't I be free to live as I see fit, as long as I don't harm anyone? Is it reasonable to believe in God?

People can buy the book and read it in advance or just turn up on the evening and hear Simon talk about it! Due to the topic and interest in the event, the evening will be an open evening for women to attend as well.
