

**Plastic Waste** Since the 2018 Blue Planet documentary highlighting plastic pollution in our

oceans, the issue of plastic waste has been in the spotlight. Some retailers are responding to the plastic problem, for example M&S customers at Cribbs Causeway can drop a variety of plastic packaging in their new recycling bins, including black ready meal trays,

crisp packets, sauce sachets and certain cosmetics containers, all of which aren't currently recycled by local councils and typically end up in landfill. The retailer has pledged to give collected plastic a new life by recycling it into store fittings, furniture and playground equipment for schools.
